Persistent Systems

Persistent has 2,000 Agile development resources, 1,400 Agile development engineers, 10 Agile coaches, 200 Scrum Masters and 50 architects. The company derives 85 percent of its application development revenue from Agile and only 15 percent from traditional development. Its 2,000-strong Agile workforce serves over 350 clients from 20 delivery centers.

The company modernizes applications through 2,000 professionals with containerization and Kubernetes skills using a microservices architecture. It has a centralized lake to source data for API needs and uses APIGEE for API catalog management/library. Persistent has partnered with 17 digital process automation partners and over 12 partners for low-code development.

Persistent has over 350 clients in CT. The CT practice has about 800 employees delivering services from 20 delivery centers. User acceptance testing and regression testing are used in more than 90 percent of engagements. Selenium and Junit are the popular testing tools used in the company engagements.

The company has over 65 clients in digital, while low-code platforms and data science have over 40 clients each. The company has CoEs for OutSystems, Appian and Ungork low-code platforms.

Persistent Systems has alliances in business automation, RPA, process discovery, security, low-code, enterprise architecture, API and integration. The company integrates performance indicators and accountability in its CoE-led approach to cater to clients' business needs.
